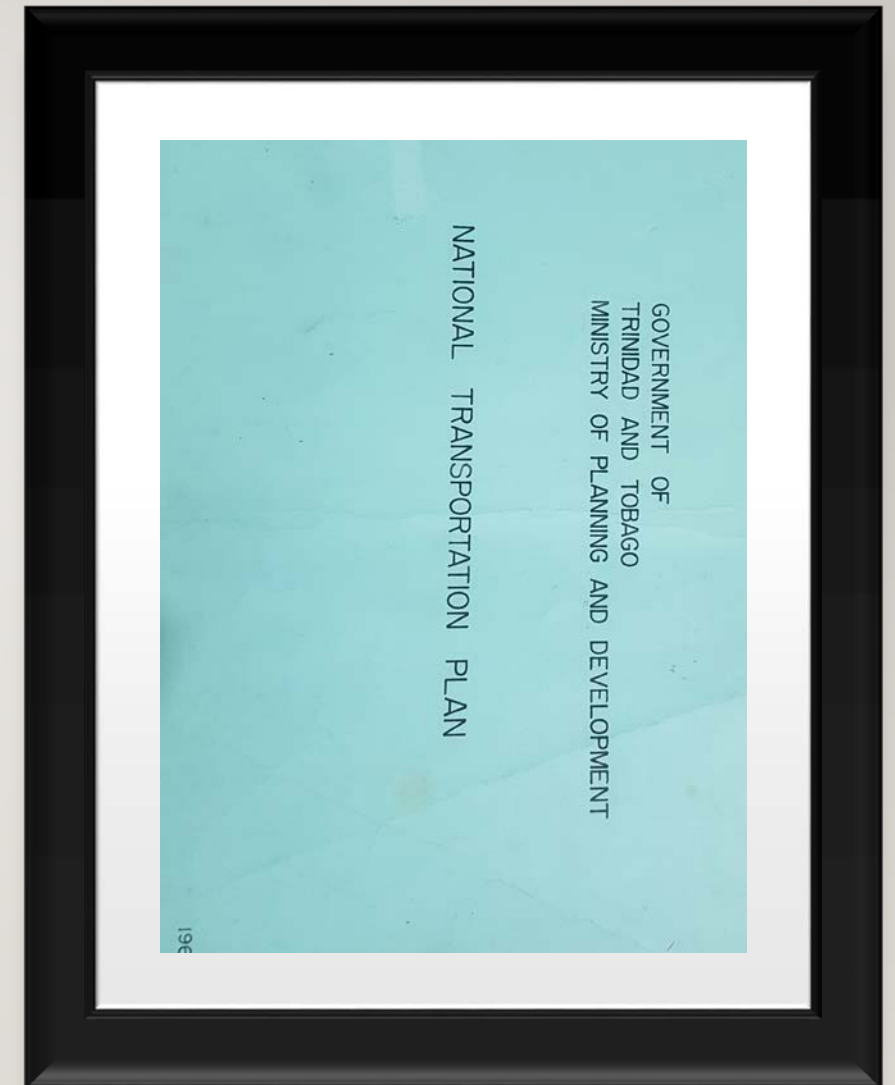

1967 NATIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN

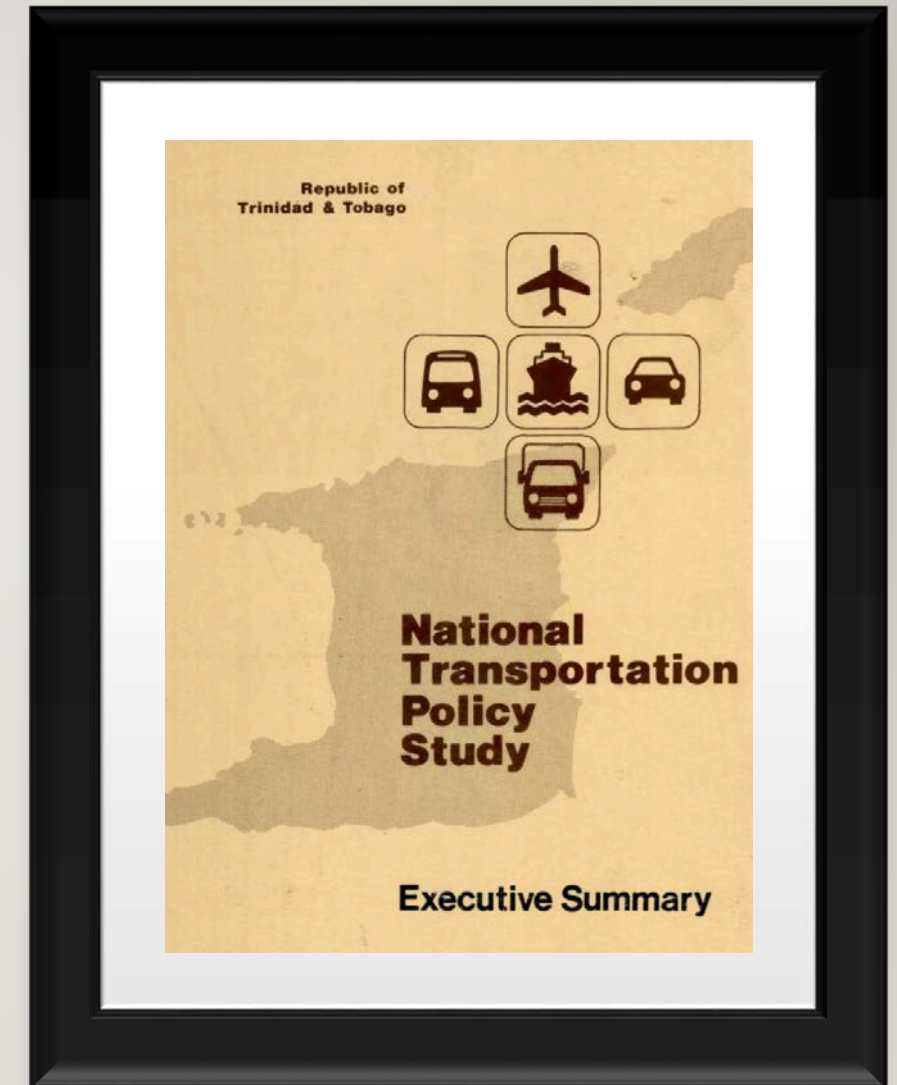

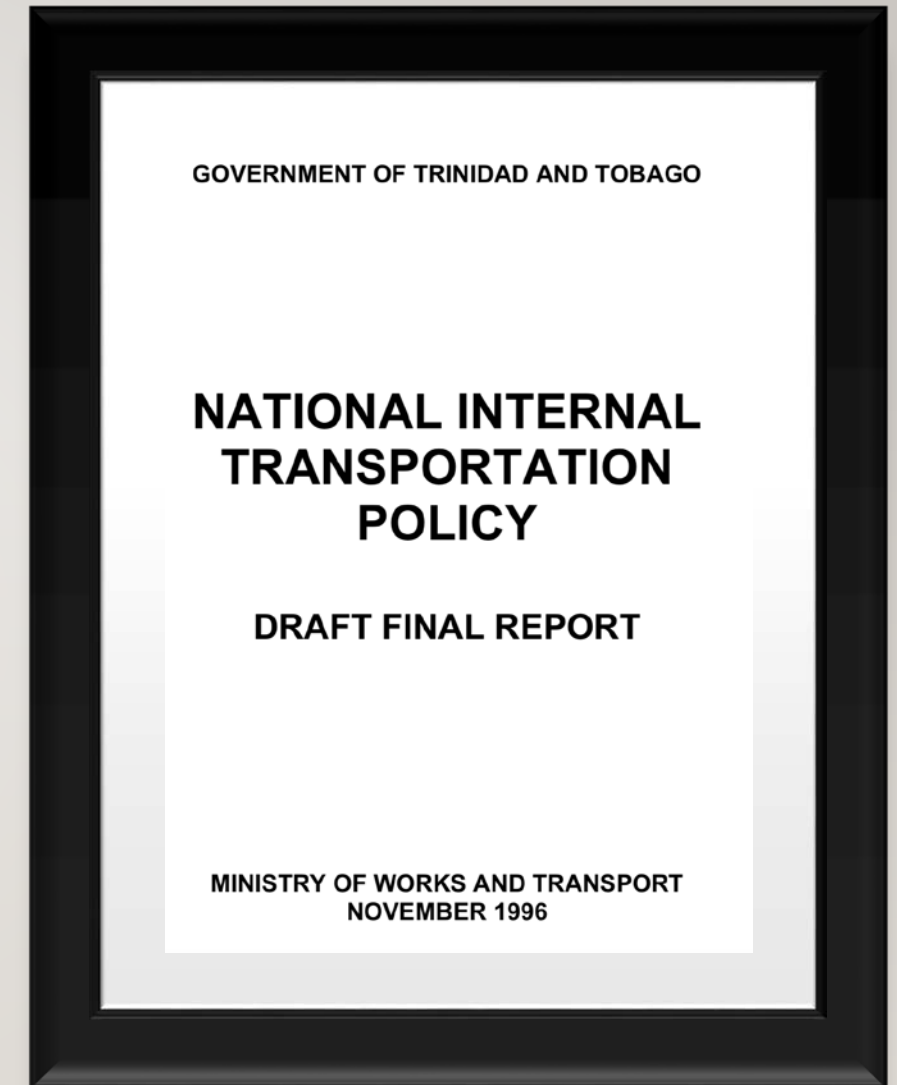

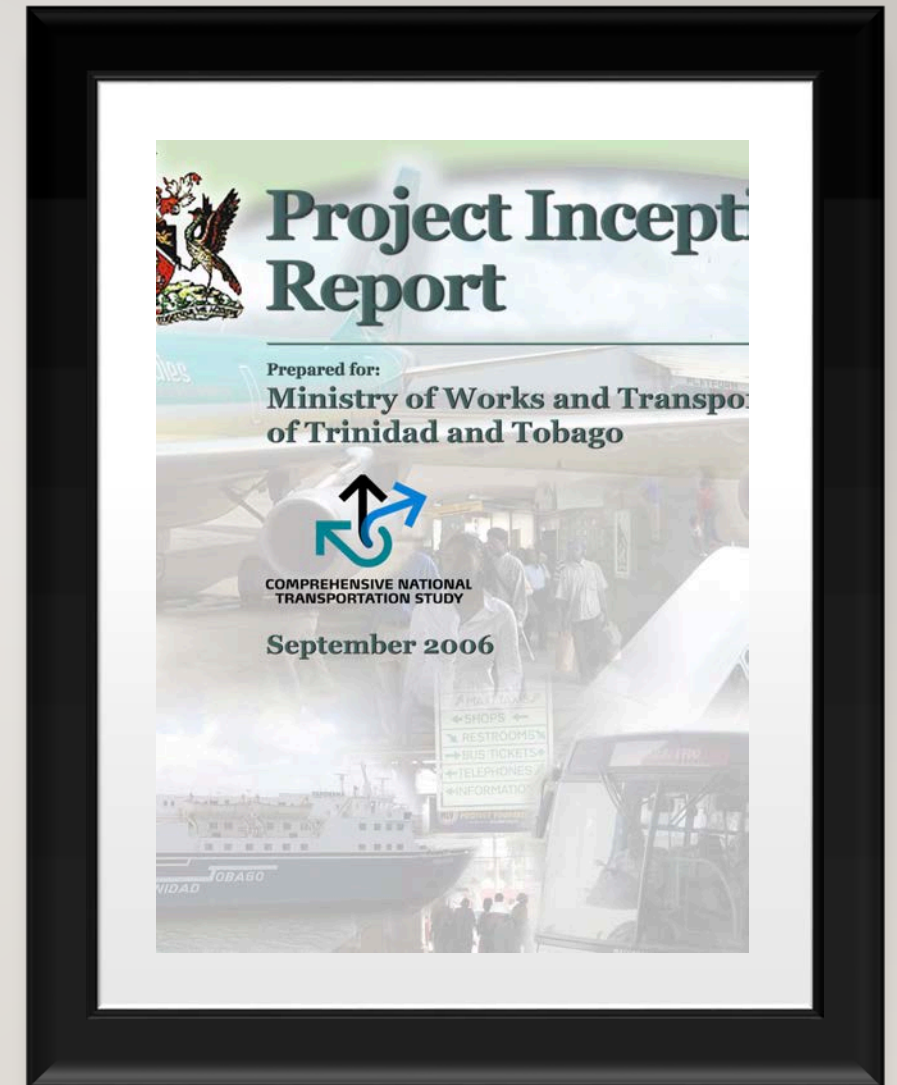
1996 NATIONAL INTERNAL TRANSPORTATION POLICY

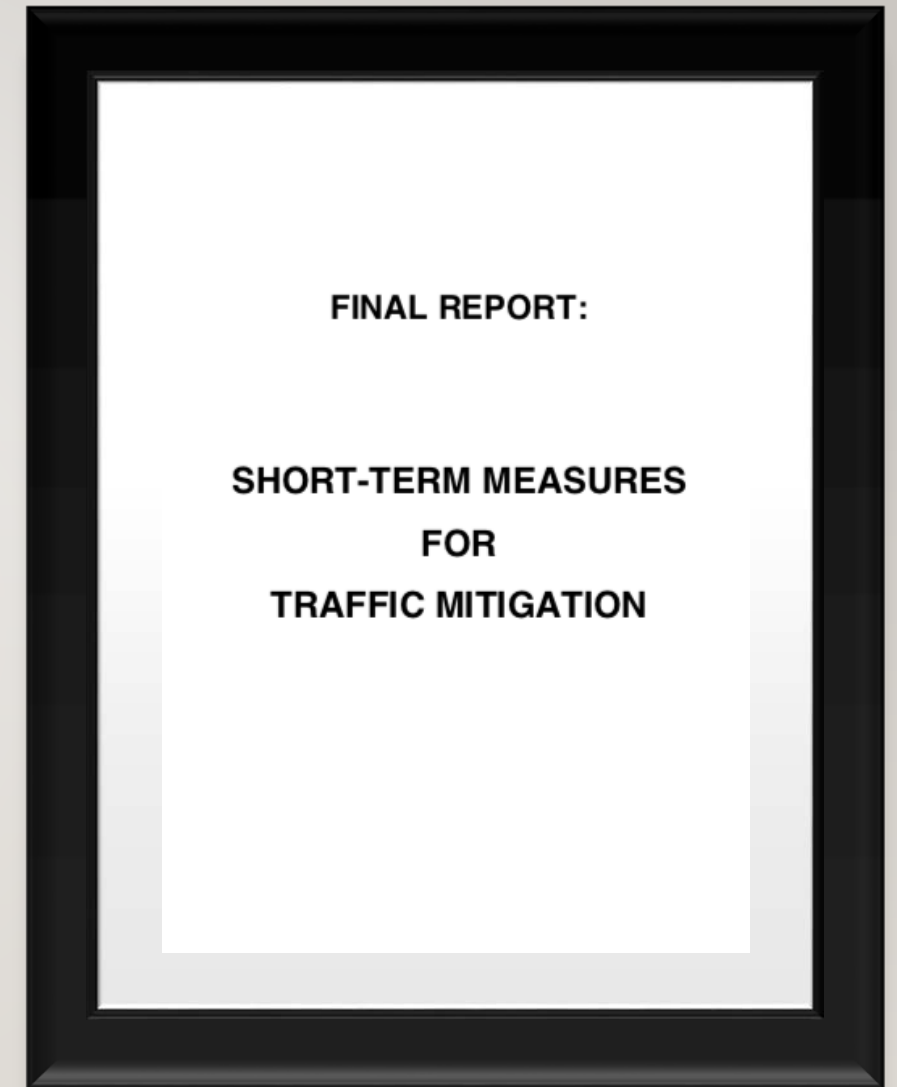
2005 COMPREHENSIVE NATIONAL TRANSPORTATION STUDY

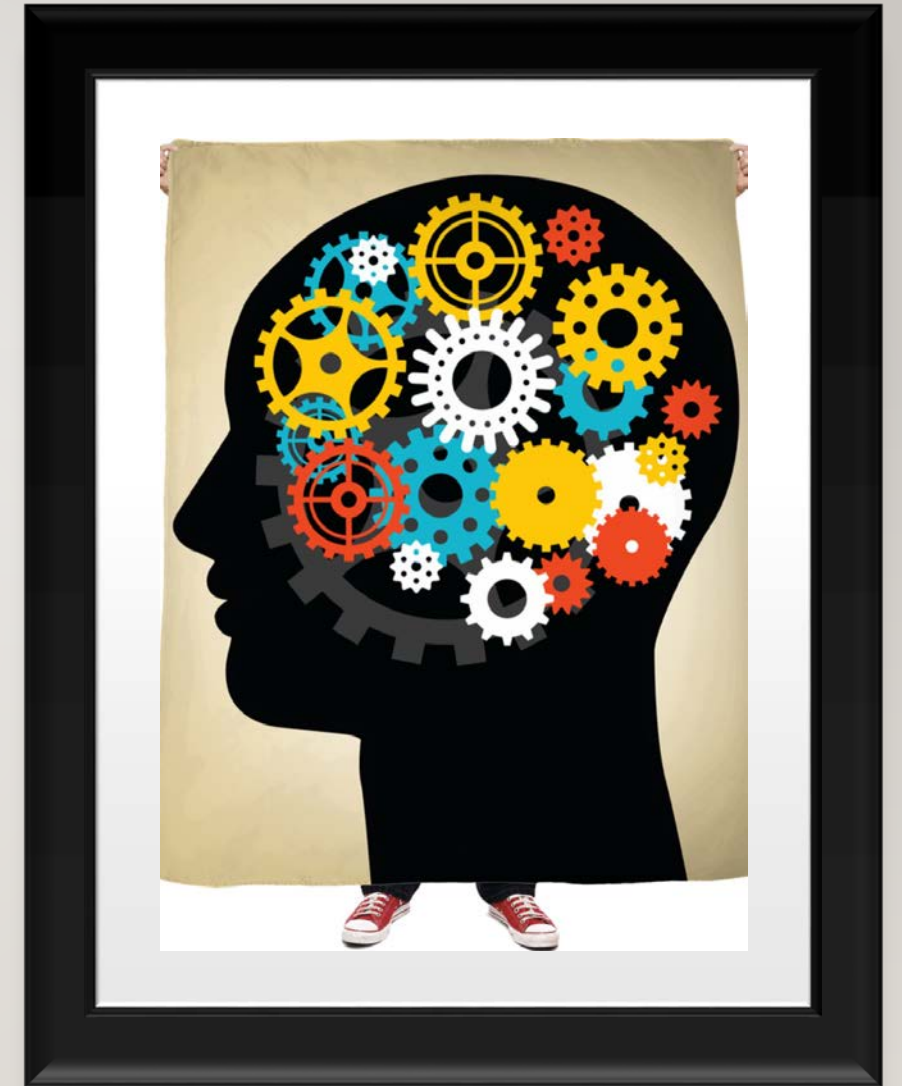
